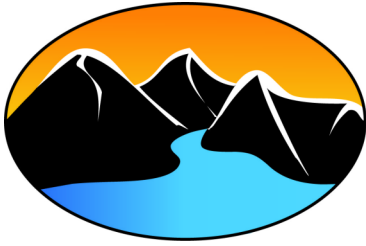

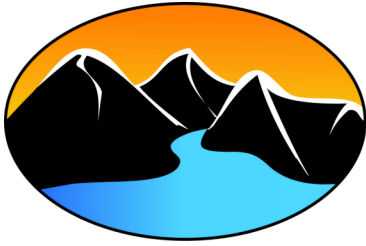
## Festival Information

Our music program will span two (2) full days from mid-morning to midnight (approximately) each day. Stage time will be negotiable, depending on your act. Bands will be provided up to one (1) hour of stage time. We will have two (2) performance stages; one larger for bands and one smaller for individual or duo act.

A complete back-line (sound system) will be on our main stage. However, we encourage you to bring your own amps, etc., but indicate to us what your needs are. Sound and stage requirements could be described as acoustic delivery needs, a chair, a music stand, change room, or wireless capability (as examples). Please be specific and please bring your own instruments.

A musician's tent will be placed by the main stage for those that are preparing to perform and require tuning of instruments, etc. Water and light snacks will be available at the festival for performing musicians as well.

Terrace is a center-hub of the pacific north and has motel, hotel, and camping amenities. We'll place the links onto our website for your convenience. Please be aware that pets are not permitted on the festival site...thank you for this.

## Guidelines and Expectations

As a participant in Music & Friends you must adhere to the following guidelines:

Violence, obscenity and inebriation are absolutely unacceptable at our festival and any performance unsuitable for a family audience will be terminated immediately. Any performers who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will have their performing privileges withdrawn.

Only performing musicians will receive a free weekend pass. Upon arrival to our festival Admissions table, performers will need to identify themselves so as to receive the weekend pass...please don't ask for special exceptions for non-performing individuals (you may note that children under 5 years of age are admitted at no charge). After you have received your weekend pass a member of the Musicians Recruitment committee who will give you instructions, directions, etc will greet you. We are a small regional music festival and we will pay only for mileage for one vehicle per band, group, or performer. In some case for out of town performers, we may also cover the cost of hotel accommodation, depending on your circumstances.

Should you want to sell your CD's/albums, a special tent, table and chairs will be made available at no cost. We do not want any commission from your sales...your sale is your sale! Just let us know ahead of time that you want to do this so we can schedule you in the tent.
